Safety & Handling

To avoid damaging your Liquid Station and to reduce the risk of personal injury, discomfort, property damage or other potential hazards, follow the precautions below and those found at linksquare.io/help

- Handle your Liquid Station with care. You may damage the apparatus if you drop, disassemble, modify, crush, bend, deform, puncture, shred, microwave, incinerate, or paint your apparatus. Do not use the Liquid Station if it has been damaged. Using a damaged apparatus may cause overheating or injury.
- Exercise care when handling liquids as part of your Liquid Station use. Do not expose your Liquid Station to rain or moisture. If it gets wet, do not turn it on. If it is already on, turn it off immediately. Allow the product to dry thoroughly before using it again. Do not attempt to dry it using an external heat source.

- Liquid Station is designed to be charged with chargers marked: Output 5V 1A. Using damaged cables or chargers, or charging when moisture is present, can cause fire, electric shock, injury, or damage to Liquid Station or other property.

- Charging or using Liquid Station in any area with a potentially explosive atmosphere, such as areas where the air contains high levels of flammable chemicals, vapors, or particles (such as grain, dust, or metal powders), may be hazardous. Obey all signs and instructions.

- Your Liquid Station and battery are integrated. You cannot remove the battery from the Liquid Station. Don't attempt to replace the Liquid Station battery yourself—you may damage the battery, which could cause overheating, fire, and injury. If the battery inside your Liquid Station is damaged or malfunctions, discontinue use of Liquid Station and contact customer support.

- Touching internal parts could result in injury or exposure to shock and/or electrical or mechanical hazards. If your Liquid Station breaks and exposes internal parts, contact customer support for assistance.

- Do not insert foreign objects into any opening on the Liquid Station, such as the USB port.

Repair & Service

Don't attempt to repair Liquid Station yourself. Disassembling the apparatus may damage it or cause injury.

Your Liquid Station should only be repaired by Stratio, Inc. or a Stratio, Inc. authorized service provider. Unauthorized repairs or modifications could result in permanent damage to the product, and may affect your warranty coverage and regulatory authorizations. Operating Temperature

Liquid Station is designed to work in ambient temperatures between 0° C (32° F) and 40° C (104° F). Liquid Station can be damaged and battery life shortened if stored or operated outside of these temperature ranges.

Care & Cleaning

Unplug Liquid Station before cleaning, during lightning storms, or when unused for extended periods of time. Use a soft, lint-free, dry cloth to clean your Liquid Station. Do not use any chemical detergent, powder, or other chemical agents (such as alcohol or benzene) to clean.

Battery Disposal

Most rechargeable lithium-ion polymer batteries are classified as non-hazardous waste and are safe for disposal in the normal municipal waste stream. Many localities have laws in place requiring battery recycling. Check your local laws to make sure that you can dispose of rechargeable batteries in your regular trash. To safely dispose of lithium-ion polymer batteries, protect terminals from exposure to other metal with packing, masking, or electrical tape so they do not cause a fire while being transported. Lithium-ion polymer batteries, however, do contain recyclable materials and are accepted for recycling by the Rechargeable Battery Recycling Corporation's (RBRC) Battery Recycling Program. Never dispose of a battery in a fire because it may explode.

Subject to the full terms and detailed information on obtaining service available at linksquare.io/legal, if you submit a valid claim under this warranty, Stratio, Inc. will either repair or replace your Liquid Station at its own discretion. All returned parts for which you have received a replacement will become the property of Stratio, Inc.

To make a claim under this Limited Warranty, contact customer support at linksquare.io/contact – available service options are dependent on the country in which service is requested and may be restricted to the original country of sale. Call charges and international shipping charges may apply, depending on the location. You must provide your name, contact information and the serial number of your Liquid Station to receive support. You may also be required to provide the original purchase receipt.

This warranty will apply only if you purchased your Liquid Station from Stratio, Inc. or its authorized resellers.

This Limited Warranty only applies to hardware components of Liquid Station, and this Limited Warranty does not apply to damage caused by: (1) normal wear and tear; (2) accidents; (3) misuse (including failure to follow product documentation); (4) neglect; (5) disassembly; (6) alterations; (7) servicing other than by Stratio, Inc. authorized technicians; and (8) external causes such as, but not limited to, water damage, exposure to sharp objects, exposure to excessive force, anomalies in the electrical current supplied to the product, and extreme thermal or environmental conditions.



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
